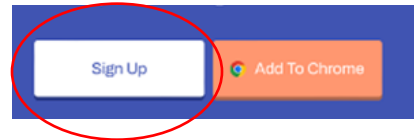


Signing up for Pedagog.ai

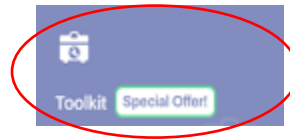

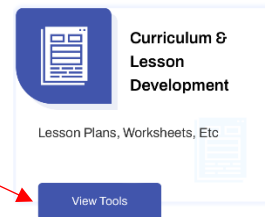
Generating a Lesson Plan in pedagog.ai

1. Sign in to Pedagog.ai.

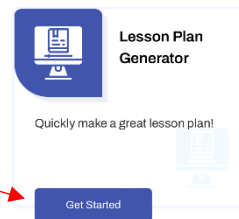
2. On the *Teacher Dashboard* page, click **Toolkit**.



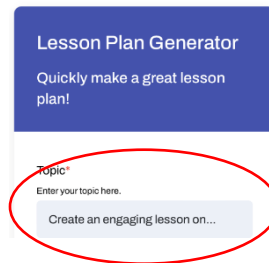
3. Inside the Toolkit, click the **View Tools** button on the *Curriculum and Lesson Development* module.

5. Type your prompt. Try to make it as specific as possible to get useful output. You can revise it as many times as you want.
